

35 WHEREAS: To accomplish their goal they had to change the name of Hemp because they
36 knew everyone knows Hemp is an amazing crop for humans and human societies and they
37 would never get away with condemning Hemp,
38
39 WHEREAS: They chose an obscure Mexican slang word: ‘marihuana’ and started
40 promoting this name into the American’s consciousness. Their goal was to insure that Hemp
41 would not be thought of as they pursued making Hemp illegal to grow and use in USA.
42
43 WHEREAS: These public officials set in place media blitzes called ‘Yellow Journalism.’
44 This Journalism is news stories with catchy headlines that get attention and sell newspapers.
45
46 WHEREAS: These news stories were not researched or backed up. Yellow Journalism is
47 used to create public opinion and sell newspapers.
48
49 WHEREAS: Because this sold newspapers many newspaper publishers ran false stories
50 emphasizing the horrors and dangers of marihuana.
51
52 WHEREAS: The “menace” of marihuana made headlines everywhere in the United States,
53 and the public learned marihuana was responsible for things such as: car accidents, losing
54 morality, braking up families and other tragedies. Negative false News Stories shaped
55 public opinion about marihuana.
56
57 WHEREAS: They, Mellon and Anslinger, continued their assassination on Hemp using
58 several made for TV movies like: ‘Reefer Madness’ (1936), ‘Marihuana: Assassin of
59 Youth’ (1935) and ‘Marihuana: The Devil’s Weed’ (1936). All were propaganda films
60 designed by these industrialists to create the enemy, marihuana.
61
62 WHEREAS: Reefer Madness was the most assassinating of these films. It depicted a man
63 going crazy from smoking marihuana, and then murdering his family with an ax.
64
65 WHEREAS: The goal of these films is to gain public support for anti-marihuana law to be
66 passed without objection.
67
68 WHEREAS: On April 14, 1937 the Prohibitive Marihuana Tax Law or the bill that
69 outlawed marihuana was directly brought to the House Ways and Means Committee.
70
71 WHEREAS: Simply put, this committee is the only committee that could introduce a bill to
72 the House floor without it being debated by other committees.
73
74 WHEREAS: The Chairman of the Ways and Means was Robert Doughton, who was also a
75 Dupont supporter with vested interest, which insured that the bill would pass Congress.
76
77 WHEREAS: In an attempt to stop this bill from being passed, Dr. James Woodward, a
78 physician and attorney, attempted to testify on behalf of the American Medical Association.
79
80 WHEREAS: Dr. Woodward stated the reason the AMA did not denounced the Marihuana
81 Tax Law sooner is the AMA just discovered that marihuana was Hemp.

82 WHEREAS: The AMA recognized Hemp as medicine found in numerous healing products
83 sold and used for quite some time. The AMA, like many others, did not realize that the
84 deadly menace they had been reading about in the media was in fact Hemp.

85

86 WHEREAS: Since these public officials: Andrew Mellon, Harry J. Anslinger, Robert
87 Doughton plotted and procured unlawful personal gain by publicly assassinating the true
88 character of Hemp, which allowed wrongfully unlawfully enacted laws prohibiting the
89 usage of Hemp, even thou Hemp was used by humans for thousands of years.

90

91 WHEREAS: Hemp became illegal to grow and use from lies, deceit and unlawful acts by
92 public officials for personal gain.

93

94 WHEREAS: The denomination of Hemp was perpetuated by decisions made by President
95 Richard Nixon during his administration in the 1970s.

96

97 WHEREAS: In 1970, Hemp was placed temporarily on the Controlled Substance Act
98 (CSA) as a Schedule I drug, the most dangerous controlled substances group.

99

100 WHEREAS: This action was pending the results of a Commission created by President
101 Richard Nixon to study Hemp.

102

103 WHEREAS: President Nixon's Commission report acknowledged that decades earlier,
104 "the absence of adequate understanding of the effects of the drug" combined with "lurid
105 accounts of largely unsubstantiated 'marihuana atrocities'" greatly affected public opinion
106 and labeled the stereotypical user as "physically aggressive, lacking in self-control,
107 irresponsible, mentally ill, and perhaps most alarming, criminally inclined and dangerous."

108

109 WHEREAS: The Commission found that the drug, marihuana, typically inhibited
110 aggression by "pacifying the user and generally produced states of drowsiness, lethargy,
111 timidity and passivity."

112

113 WHEREAS: President Nixon's Commission recommended decriminalization of simple
114 possession, finding: "The criminal law is too harsh a tool to apply to personal possession
115 even in the effort to discourage use.

116

117 WHEREAS: The Commission states an overwhelming indictment of the behavior, which
118 they believe is inappropriate, "The actual and potential harm of use of the drug, marihuana
119 is not great enough to justify intrusion by the criminal law into private behavior, a step
120 which our society takes only with the greatest reluctance."

121

122 WHEREAS: President Nixon's National Commission on Marihuana and Drug Abuse
123 recommended that Hemp prohibition end. To remove Hemp from the Controlled Substance
124 Act (CSA) Schedule I.

125

126 WHEREAS: Instead of following his Commission's findings, President Nixon signed the
127 Controlled Substance Act CSA adding Hemp/Marihuana permanently on the Schedule I
128 drug list.

129 WHEREAS: As a result, last year over 850,000 people in America were arrested for
130 marihuana-related crimes.

131

132 WHEREAS: To bluster their existence; Police unions, prison guard unions, private
133 corporations which run prison corporations lobby US Congress to continue having Hemp
134 classified as a Schedule I drug.

135

136 WHEREAS: To defer competition; alcohol/beer companies, cigarette companies, Big
137 Pharmaceutical Companies, and others lobby US Congress to keep Hemp classified as a
138 Schedule I drug.

139

140 WHEREAS: To this day Hemp is wrongfully characterized to keep it illegal and from legal
141 growing in the United States.

142

143 WHEREAS: Do to unlawful processes used to enactment the Marijuana Tax Act and the
144 reckless and non-scientific actions of President Nixon adding hemp to the Control
145 Substance Act Schedule I listing.

146

147 WHEREAS: It is required the enactment of the **HEMP RESOLUTION BILL** to correct
148 and redeem passed inappropriate unlawful actions against GOD'S CREATION – **HEMP**.

BODY

151

152 Based on the historical facts presented in the **PREAMBLE** Hemp is created by **GOD** for
153 the benefit of all of Humans and Human Societies and was used for thousands of years
154 until late 1930s in the United States. Then, Andrew Mellon, Hoover's Secretary of the
155 Treasury and Dupont's primary investor, declared Hemp was dangerous and a threat to his
156 billion dollar enterprise.

157

158 This public official orchestrated a propaganda campaign against Hemp to demonized it,
159 which allowed the unlawfully enactment of laws prohibiting the usage of Hemp in 1937.
160 Then in 1970s, even though President Nixon's National Commission on Marihuana and
161 Drug Abuse recommended that Hemp prohibition end, President Nixon wrongfully added
162 Hemp to the Controlled Substance Act Schedule 1.

163

164 The time has come NOW to enact the **HEMP RESOLUTION BILL** to correct and
165 redeem the inappropriate unlawful acts passed, Marijuana Tax Act, against GOD'S
166 CREATION – **HEMP**, and have it removed from the Controlled Substance Act (CSA) to
167 bring **HEMP** back to what **GOD** created it for before the 1930s, a Commercial Crop and
168 regulate it according to its use: the Unite States Department of Agriculture (USDA) as a
169 commercial farm crops, the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF)
170 as a recreational commodity and the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) as a medical
171 commodity.

172

173 "When he lies, he speaks his native language, for he is a liar and the father of lies" (John
174 8:44). You speak Satan's language when you lie. **STOP THE LIES** Bring the United State
175 together by enactment of the **HEMP RESOLUTION BILL** and stop the State-by-State
176 Hemp legislation.

ENACTMENT

179 Passing the **HEMP RESOLUTION BILL** cancels the inappropriate unlawful Marijuana
180 Tax Act and removes Hemp from the Controlled Substance Act (CSA). Bringing Hemp
181 back to what **GOD** created HEMP for before the 1930s. A Commercial Crop regulated
182 according to its use: by the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) as a
183 commercial farm crop, by the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives
184 (ATF) as a recreational commodity and by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) as a
185 medical commodity.

186

187 Becomes the **HEMP RESOLUTION ACT** after being signed by the President of the
188 United States and is effective 91 days from the Signing and Enactment Date.
